Order No. 1789/2007 of the Ministry of Environment and Sustainable Development on approval of the procedure for the issuance of the environment permit

It is decided that the competent authority entitled to put into operation the procedure for the issuance of the environmental permit is either: i) the central authority for environment protection, ii) the National Agency for Environment Protection, or iii) the territorial public authority for environment protection. Rules on issuance and revision of the environmental permit as well as on approval of specific activities are enacted.

Decision No. 969/2007 of the Constitutional Court regarding the unconstitutionality exception of the provisions of art. 612 alin. 6 of the Code for Civil Procedure.

The Court admitted the exception and ascertained that the provisions of art. 612 alin. 6 of the Code for Civil Procedure (i.e. "The interrogation cannot be used as evidence for proving the divorce reasons") are unconstitutional, in the light of the provisions of art. 16 alin. 1 of the Romanian Constitution (i.e. "Citizens are equal before the law and public authorities, without any privilege or discrimination") and of art. 21 alin. 3 of the Romanian Constitution ("The parties are entitled to have a fair trial and to have their causes solved within a reasonable period of time").
